GENERAL GUIDELINES

- The course is open to Members only. Guests are not permitted at this time.
- Play is restricted to four golfers per tee time.
- Members are not permitted to play if displaying one or more symptoms of Coronavirus.
- Golfers must always ensure clear distance between groups.
- The Clubhouse remains closed. Toilet facilities in the Clubhouse will be available, with hand sanitisers available for Members' use.
- The Cabin will be open each day except Tuesdays & Thursdays (weekdays 9:00am to 2:00pm, Saturdays 8:30am to 4:30pm and Sundays 8:30am to 2:30pm.) Take-Away service only. Outside of these times the toilet facilities will be closed.
- The practice ground may be used in line with Club Policy. (This can be found on the Club website.)
- No competitions, matches etc. will be played initially but will begin week commencing 12th April.
- Members must only play at pre-booked times outlined. **STRICTLY NO PLAY OUTSIDE OF ALLOCATED TEE TIMES.**
- Players may "cut in" and do not have to play holes in order. Players must ensure that there is 1 hole clear if cutting in.

BOOKING TEE TIMES

- Start sheets are published on the V1 system on rolling 13-day basis. Start sheets will go live at 8:45pm.
- Tee times are available at ten-minute intervals from 45 minutes after sunrise until one hour before sunset. On Mondays and Fridays, the first start time will be at 8:30am so greens staff can mow the fairways.
- Due to limited staffing in the Pro Shop, all tee time bookings should be managed online using the Club V1 app. Only in exceptional cases should this be managed by calling the Pro Shop. If your call cannot be answered immediately, it will be returned as quickly as is feasible.
- In-any 13-day rolling period, each member can have three live bookings confirmed at any one time. (*This excludes any bookings for Board competitions.*) Only when the first of these tee bookings has been played can another tee time be booked. This will be monitored, and appropriate action taken including cancellation of additional bookings if required.
- If there are tee times still available on the actual day of play, Members will be able to book additional times online over and above this allowance. Members **must** phone the Club to do this.
- Members who are able to play midweek are respectfully requested to consider those who are limited to playing at weekends when making their tee bookings, and book midweek only.
- We will be monitoring demand constantly and will adjust regulations accordingly.

REGISTERING FOR PLAY AT THE CLUB

- Members **must** remain in their vehicles until 10 minutes before their pre-booked tee time.
- Members **must** register at the Pro shop prior to play.
 - Professional staff will be on duty from 07h50 in the week and 06h50 at weekends having set up a 2m barrier at the entrance of the shop.
 - They will ensure that social distancing is maintained when Members register.
 - Pro shop staff will be wearing the appropriate PPE.
- Members playing in a tee time either before or after the professional's shop is open must ensure all policies and procedures are maintained.
- As changing facilities are not available, Members **must** change their shoes in the car park.
- Members requiring the trolley store **must** use the hand sanitiser provided before and after using the facility.
- Rental buggies are not available for hire. Private buggies may only be used by one person unless from the same household.

PLAYING THE COURSE

- Maintain a safe distance from your playing partners. (2 metres)
- Pay attention to social distancing on tees and greens.
- Maintain safe distance (2 metres) from all staff at Club.
- Common courtesies (handshakes and other embraces) must be avoided.
- Leave the flag in the hole at all times. **DO NOT TOUCH THE FLAG STICK.**
- Only pick up your own golf ball and ensure it is easily identifiable. Do **not** pick up any lost balls you may find.
- There are no rakes, ball scoops, or ball washers on the course.
- All members have been provided with their own rakes. If you have not collected one from the professional's shop, please do so.
- On the 9th and 15th, only ring the bell by striking it with a club. Do not use the bell ropes / chains.
- Maintain a safe distance from other groups.
- Golfers must return to their cars and leave the car park as soon as their round is completed.
- It is essential that a good pace of play is maintained, with all groups remaining in position on the course.

PROFESSIONALS TEACHING

Any golf coaching should adhere to the following guidance to ensure the safety of both customers and PGA Professional staff: -

- A 2-metre exclusion zone will be created around the pupil that no one enters.
- Professionals moving a pupil into position will use an alignment stick, which is easy to wipe down with a sanitising wipe before and after the lesson.
- Payments must be made by bank transfer only.
